

**Stand for environmental justice and a clean energy future --  
Act today to tell the CPUC you are not going to pay PG&E  
to build two new polluting plants in Contra Costa!**

PG&E WANTS TWO NEW POWER PLANTS WHEN NONE ARE NEEDED  
both would be in Contra Costa County, which already has too many by powerplants

- The plants, in Antioch and Oakley, would be paid for by the people who pay PG&E electric bill
- California currently has 30% in electricity “reserves.” The new plants are not needed.
- The new power plants will crowd out renewable energy.
- Renewable energy adds more jobs, and better careers
- Commission will vote on Oakley and Antioch power plants tomorrow, July 29, 2010
- This is a PG&E race to pollute -- **PG&E senior vice president of energy procurement Fong Wan stated clearly that PG&E** is trying to begin construction on both plants before July 1st of 2011 to avoid the new, stricter regulations to reduce greenhouse gases.

These plants would Exacerbate Environmental Injustice in Contra Costa

- In a report from the Contra Costa Asthma Coalition: “Childhood asthma rates for children ages 5-17 in Contra Costa County is 23.7%, while the national average is 14.2%”
- In 2008 Bay Area Quality Management District Staff concludes that: “Estimated toxic air pollution-related cancer risk in the Antioch area [which includes Oakley and Pittsburg] is **30-60 times higher** than the level commonly deemed acceptable in California (assuming lifetime exposure).”
- U.S. EPA: “The incidence of stroke- and cancer-related deaths in Contra Costa County are both **significantly** higher than the state average”
