YES Prop

CLEAN ENERGY & JOBS ACT: Prop 39 will close a tax loophole for out-of-state businesses operating in California. Prop 39 will generate \$500 million in annual General Fund revenue and \$1 billion a year after 5 years, allocating \$550 million a year to fund clean energy projects and creates 20,000 to 30,000 construction-related jobs.

YES Prop

CA RIGHT TO KNOW GENETICALLY ENGINEERED FOOD ACT: Prop 37 requires food sold in retail outlets to be labeled if it contains genetically modified materials. These products would not be allowed to be labeled as "natural."

YES PA

SCHOOLS & LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY PROTECTION ACT: Prop 30 will temporarily raise personal income taxes up to 3% over the next 7 years **only** on incomes starting at \$250,000 and over, and increases the sales tax by ½ of one cent for 4 years. Revenues would go toward education.

PAYCHECK PROTECTION INITIATIVE: If passed Prop 32 will prohibit unions from directing their payroll deductions toward union dues, blocking their only source of income. Vote NO on Prop 32.
