Power Charge Indifference Adjustment

This fee is required by PG&E of all MCE customers, including fixed and low-income customers enrolled with the California Alternative Rates for Energy (CARE) program. It is intended to ensure that customers who switch to MCE pay for energy that PG&E procured on their behalf, prior to their switch.


