

## PG&E Power Charge Indifference Adjustment Rates

The Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (PCIA)\* is a charge assessed by PG&E to cover generation costs acquired prior to a customer's change in service provider. This fee is collected by PG&E and is effectively an "exit fee" assessed to customers which receive their generation services from another provider. PG&E assigns customers a "PCIA Vintage" based on the date they were enrolled in alternative service. These rates are updated each January by PG&E.

Customers enrolled in PG&E's Medical Baseline Allowance program are not subject to the PCIA fee.
