The Department of Toxic
Substances Control (DTSC)
provides oversight of these sites
with known soil & water
contamination. Soil and soil
vapor testing have shown high
levels of lead, arsenic, volatile
organic compounds (VOCs) like
PCE, TCE, PCBs and benzene.



Without a comprehensive and sufficient cleanup plan, these contaminants will continue harming the environment and potentially impact the respiratory, nervous, digestive and reproductive system and cause cancer.









- DTSC suspects that families living on Santa Fe Ave may be exposed to vapor intrusion.
- DTSC needs access to people's homes to do indoor air quality testing and inform residents of the potential dangers of VOCs.
- The reason for contamination is due to years of industrial and manufacturing use next to residential homes.
- To effectively address potential vapor intrusion, DTSC needs to test homes for their indoor air quality levels.
